1. Verified that the door is unlocked.
2. Meeting called to order @ 5:05 p.m. by Vice Chairman Joe Snow.
3. **Approve minutes of previous regular meeting:** Motion to approve minutes of the previous meeting by David Tschudy; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Isaiah Carlson. Motion carried on voice vote.
4. **Review Emergency Management updates:** Emergency Management (EMG) Director Gary Ziegler advised the committee on EPCRA/EMPG Grant information; trainings, and initiative updates.
5. **Training requests:** Sheriff Kanable had the following training requests:
  - 1) K-9 Sergeant to attend K-9 recertification training in Valparaiso, IN from March 9-10 with one overnight;
  - 2) A Detective to attend Advanced Property/Evidence Management training Green Bay, WI on April 2, with one overnight and a registration fee of \$149.00;
  - 3) A Detective to attend Fire and Explosion Related Death training in Sturgeon Bay, WI on April 27-28 with two overnights and a registration cost of \$325.00.Isaiah Carlson made a motion to approve the training request; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dawn Sass. Motion carried by voice vote.
6. **Review jail population and jail medical issues:** Sheriff Kanable updated the committee on the jail population and medical incidents for the month of January.
7. **Review building project updates:** Sheriff Kanable provided updates on the building project and upcoming meetings.
8. **Review and approve Sheriff Office updates:** Sheriff Kanable updated the committee on the patrol activity, staffing and dispatch operations for the month.
9. **Review monthly budget:** Sheriff Kanable advised that the numbers are on track.
10. **Review 2025 budgets and approve non-lapsing funds to 2026 budgets:** Business Manager Dana Weber and Sheriff Kanable advised that the Emergency Management department has not received all of the 2025 grant funding to close out the books and monies will have to come from the general fund to cover what the grants do not.

The Sheriff's department will have to use about \$189,000 of non-lapsed funds that were budgeted to use this year and the department would like to non-lapse any remaining funds to the 2026 Sheriff's budget. Business Manager Weber advised with the decrease in revenues and increase in expenses the non-lapsing funds will definitely help the 2026 budget.

David Tschudy made a motion to non-lapse remaining 2025 non-lapsing monies to the 2026 budget; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Isaiah Carlson. Motion carried.
11. **Audit bills:** The Department Bills were reviewed and signed. A motion was made by David Tschudy to approve the bills; seconded by Isaiah Carlson. Motion carried on voice vote.
11. **Next meeting:** Next meeting date is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, March 12 at 5:00p.m. Isaiah Carlson moved to adjourn and David Tschudy seconded. Motion carried on voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 5:36 p.m. by Vice-Chairman Joe Snow.
