Meeting Minutes from April 12, 2022

1. Verified that door is unlocked.
2. Meeting called to order @ 5:45 p.m. by Chairperson Richard Thoman.
3. **Approve minutes of previous regular meeting:** Motion to approve minutes of the previous meeting by John Bernstein; 2nd by Aaron Withee; Motion carried.
4. **Review Emergency Management updates:** Emergency Management (EMG) Director Tanna McKeon is on vacation and will update the committee next month.
5. **Review and possible updates on radio system:** Chief Deputy Thomas Moczynski advised that all sites are up and running. The generators are all installed and just dealing with minor issues. Chief Moczynski indicated that hopefully, the project will be completed in June.
6. **Training Requests:** Chief Moczynski had the following training request:
 - 1) One patrol deputy to attend SWAT Command Decision Making and Leadership in Manitowoc, WI, from May 15-20 with five overnights and a registration cost of \$750.00.Joe Snow made a motion to approve the training requests; 2nd by Aaron Withee. Motion carried.
7. **Review jail population and jail medical issues:** Chief Moczynski advised that the jail housed 35 inmates in February and 43 in March. The department has averaged 6 inmates on the electronic bracelet. There were four ambulance calls for inmates in the jail in February, none in March and three so far this month, with them all returning to jail.
8. **Review Public Safety and Department updates:** Chief Moczynski updated the committee that the dispatch, jail and patrol departments are short staffed due to new hires resigning, so looking to hire a dispatcher, a male and female jailer and one patrol deputy. Chief Moczynski indicated that there are three employees currently going to the jail academy and the department has hired two new patrol deputies. The department has hired a Jail Corporal for night shift. The county had two fatalities in the month of March. One on March 7 on State Hwy 11 by Browntown and the other on the 31 on State Hwy 104. Chief Moczynski advised the on the 30, the department issued a press release that the department and other agencies were able to solve about 22 burglaries that were done by juveniles.
9. **Review monthly budget:** The department budget looks to be on track and it is early in the year.
10. **Audit bills:** The department bills were reviewed and signed. A motion was made by Joe Snow and seconded by John Bernstein to approve the bills. Motion carried.
11. **Next Meeting:** The next meeting date is on Tuesday, May 10, 2022, at 5:45 p.m. at the Sheriff's Office training center. John Bernstein moved to adjourn and Aaron Withee seconded. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:12 p.m. by Chairman Thoman.
