2. **Update on CJCC:**
 - Treatment Court's request for clarification from the GCSO regarding the use of jail sanction(s).
 - The Sherriff will follow-up with staff at the jail. Will have a further discussion.
 - The Green County Jail is currently down three jailers.
 - Women inmates are coming back to the jail as of 5/5/2023.
3. **Update on Drug Court:**
 - General Update: Progress in the Court.
 - Timeline: February 2023-End of April 2023.
 - Terminations: One male participant (in February) due to non-compliance.
 - Graduations: There have been no graduations in this quarter. (We did have one female graduate this morning, which will count for next quarter).
 - Green County: 14 participants (13/1 female)
 - Of the Green County clients, two are strictly OWI participants (both 4th offenses).
 - Lafayette County: 3 clients (2 males/1 female)
 - Of the Lafayette County clients, all substance use clients.
 - (Not accounted for, two male participants in DOC treatment).
 - Pending start dates:
 - We have (5) Green County males pending a start date.
 - 1 male OWI 3rd offense.
 - 1 males OWI 4th offense.
 - 2 males with substance use.
 - Referrals since February 2022 to current:
 - Lafayette (0)
 - Green (5)
 - 1 female (substance-crack cocaine)
 - 1 male (3rd OWI/history of substance use)
 - 1 male (THC)
 - 1 male (opiates)
 - 1 male (poly substance)
