General Update: Progress in the Court

- Data from the Treatment Court during this quarter.
  - Timeframe: 05/2023-07/31/2023.
    - Referrals:
      - 1-Lafayette County Referral
        - Male (Substance)
          - This individual was assessed and accepted into the program and began at the end of July.
      - 8- Green County Referrals
        - 6 males (2-4<sup>th</sup> OWI, 3-Substance, 1-Alcohol, No OWI).
          - 2-4<sup>th</sup> OWI:
            - Both males were assessed and accepted and have begun the Treatment Court program.
          - 3 Substance:
            - 1 male was assessed and accepted into the Treatment Court program.
            - 1 male denied due to residency criteria (being outside of Green and/or Lafayette County).
            - 1 male awaiting to staff his case with the Treatment Court team.
          - 1-Alcohol:
            - 1 male denied due to not having met Treatment Court criteria (high risk/high need).
        - 2 females (1-Substance, 1-3<sup>rd</sup> OWI).
          - 1-Substance:
            - Female did not return Treatment Court's attempts to schedule her assessment.
          - 1-3<sup>rd</sup> OWI:
            - Female was assessed and accepted into the Treatment Court program.

- Graduations: 2 male participants (both Green).
- Terminations: 1 male (Green).
  - Pending: 2 male participants (Lafayette)/2 male participants (Green).
