- 1. Call the meeting to order.
  - Meeting called to order by Chair Harvey Mandel at 9:00 a.m.
- 2. Approval of September 11, 2023 meeting minutes.

  Motion to approve minutes made by Mark Gundlach and seconded by Russ Torkelson.

  Voice vote with all "ayes"; motion carried.
- 3. Audit bills.
  - Motion to approve September 2023 bills in the amount of \$1,101.744.06 Mark Gundlach and seconded by Russ Torkelson. Voice vote with all "ayes"; motion carried.
- 4. Reports from administrative staff.
  - General Superintendent Eric Wild advised paving is almost completed and provided a construction update.
  - Patrol Superintendent John Schumacher provided updates on bridge and culvert projects. Commissioner Chris Narveson provided a shop update.

- 6. Discussion on winter brush and tree cutting for local governments. *Discussion was held on a price increase for 2023-2024.*
- 7. Discussion and possible action on updating County Code Title 2, Highway Access, Additional Requirements.
  - Discussion was held on revising 3-6-5-6: B to increase the minimum from 24 feet to 30 feet requirement and an additional inspection fee of \$100.00. A motion was made by Mark Gundlach to approve the changes and seconded by Russ Torkelson. Voice vote with all "ayes": motion carried.
- 8. Discussion and possible action on installing additional stop sign, stop ahead sign and rumble strips at CTH N located south of STH 81.
  - The Committee was advised that the Traffic Safety Commission made a motion in the September meeting of recommendation to install an additional stop sign and install rumble strips on CTH N (North).
